GUIDELINES FOR BESSIE F. BURTON PARADE OF STATES PARTICIPATION

We are encouraging all Jurisdictions to participate in our Annual Queen and Lady In Waiting Pageant.

Queen participants must raise a minimum of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars in order to be a contestant and Lady In Waiting participants must raise a minimum of two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars in order to be a contestant.

- ➤ All Jurisdictions are requested to complete the Bessie F. Burton Parade of States Informational Form, whether you will have a Queen and/or Lady In Waiting Contestant. This information is needed for our program. Also, it will allow us to know where you will come in for the parade. The Host Jurisdiction will enter last.
- ➤ The winner of the queen contest will receive a reasonable roundtrip transportation from her state to the next General Conference Grand Session. In addition, if she reports more than three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars, she will be eligible to receive a free single room for Saturday and Sunday night. The accommodations will be for the 2024 General Grand Conference. The Queen will be responsible to provide to the Bessie F. Burton Parade of States Chairperson a copy of the transportation receipt upon arrival to the hotel.
- ➤ Monetary prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - o For the Queen: \$150.00 for first place; \$100.00 for second place and \$75.00 for third place.
 - Lady In Waiting: \$100.00 for first place; \$75.00 for second place and \$50.00 for third place.
